Dear Washington County Wildlife Society:

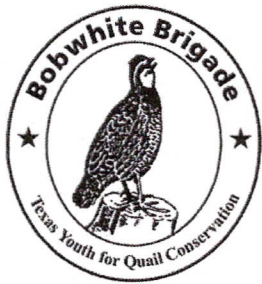

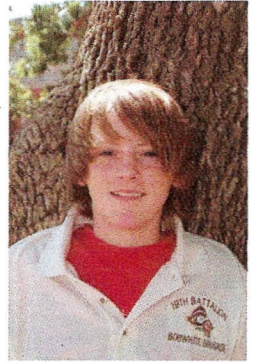
